

BREAKS THE 10,000-RIDER MILESTONE!

10,000 Celebrate Bike to Work & School Day

Bike to Work and School Day broke the 10,000 participant milestone for the first time in its 14 year history in Whatcom County on Friday, May 20, 2011. Up 20% from 2010 participation, the growth in popularity shows that bicycling and walking for transportation is both something to celebrate and an integral part of local

culture.

Bike to Work and School Day is promoted by everybodyBIKE, the bicycle program of Whatcom Smart Trips. The event has grown from one Celebration Station in 1998 to over 50 Celebration Stations at schools, businesses. and community centers all around the county. More than 100 volunteers prepare and staff the stations; an equal number of businesses donate prizes and refreshments to reward the

growing numbers of children, adults, and seniors on bicycles, tricycles and even unicycles. The event is part of National Bike to Work day celebrated every year on the third Friday in May.

For the first year ever, grocery stores participated in "Bike to Shop Day" by hosting all-day Celebration Stations to reward people who bicycle or walk for daily shopping trips. More than one hundred people at three participating markets enjoyed Bike to Shop treats and gifts and the chance to win raffle prizes of \$50 cash cards and more. "I work at home." said one executive, "so Bike to Shop makes it possible for me to participate in this terrific community celebration."

Festivities extended throughout the day with a pancake breakfast, live music, Tricycle Relay Races, an evening beer garden, and lots of prizes. Nearly 100% of all Bellingham public schools hosted

> Celebration Stations. Public and private schools in Ferndale, Lynden, Blaine, and Burlington-Edison also hosted stations.

> > For schools, Bike and Walk to School Day is a teaching and learning opportunity. Jeff Boersma, Principal of Lynden Christian School, explained to students, staff and parents: "Too often. many people just jump into a car for every short trip. Gas is expensive, and cars pollute. Many of our daily trips are only 1-4 miles, which only takes a few minutes by bike. This day is to

promote the option of walking and cycling as a normal almost every day activity. Honor God with exercise, clean air, and healthy living!"

Bellingham has been a nationally recognized "Bicycle Friendly Community" at the Silver level since 2005, as designated by the League of American Bicyclists. Bellingham residents use bicycles for 6% of all trips, almost as high as Portland, Oregon's 7% bicycle mode share. Nationwide, bicycle use as a percentage of all trips is 0.9%. Washington ranks as the number one "Bicycle Friendly State" nationwide, as evaluated by the League of American Bicyclists.

If you *must* park on the north side of Samish Way, please provide a 50+ foot buffer so Galbraith Lane residents can see down the road.
